ABOUT KNOWLEDGE FOR CHILDREN

Knowledge for children Uganda operates to invest in the quality education for children in rural areas. Their vision is to invest in the knowledge of children and the knowledge of teachers, parents and the local community as a whole, they work tirelessly, contributing to communities' self-reliance and improving the quality of education. In corporation with and support of the government and their partners, they want nothing more than to raise the level of education to a structurally higher level in the rural areas of Uganda.

Schools in Uganda are typically under equipped, with only one form of teaching to fit all, class repetition. This leaves children with a lack of understanding into subjects and alienates pupils with varied learning styles.

In 2015, from the runner's fundraising, we funded textbooks for three schools for an entire year! This has enabled us to improve the education of 1,240 children for ever. We don't want this successful partnership to stop!

Runners in 2016 will be fundraising so that we can add another 3 schools to this program, which through training and community engagement really does encompass all the best practices of a helping hand, not a donation system.

SEPTEMBER '16 PROJECT UPDATE

Knowledge for Children is currently undergoing major growth expanding its work out to 30 more schools and also into Kenya. This is an incredible achievement and really proves that their partnership program - schools and parents, really works.

But in this growth they haven't forgotten about Masaka. They have even taken on extra schools within Masaka and one of them is Bugabira Primary school., one of the Uganda Marathon's other projects.

The way the marathon links projects to share skills and experience is one of its greatest achievements. Knowledge for Children is now going to empower Bugabira teachers to be able to fully utilise exercise books to create interactive child led learning. This will mean that already outstanding exam results that Bugabira has been producing will improve further, with children with different styles of learning all being able to learn at the same rate.



This year we are going to continue to support the 3 Masaka schools we have been working with whilst also adding another 3 schools. This will grow our impact through Knowledge for Children to reach 2,500 children.
